

2026 REDHILL FISHING



Dear Redhill Members:

The Fishing Committee is pleased to announce the start of the 2026 season.

Before accessing any Fishing Area, you must complete the process below and confirm that you are included on the new 2026 Authorized Fishing Member List.

The 2025 Authorized Fishing Member List is obsolete effective March 31, 2026, and previously issued keys are no longer valid as locks will be rekeyed on or around that date.

Download the application. We continue to follow the process we've used for the last three seasons that allows for easy review and, most importantly, accurate management of the authorized fishing list. The volunteer members of the Fishing Committee maintain the real-time list. A link to the 2026 fishing access request form (2026 Form) and the Authorized Fishing Member List are included on the fishing page of the Association's website at the Fish/Hunt/Camp tab on the redhillforesthoa.com website.

Simplified renewal application process. If you are renewing from 2025 and have no changes in status, simply pay for a new key and submit the completed 2026 form without the additional information provided in prior years (e.g., photos, second form of identification, etc.)

If you plan to fish this season, please submit a completed 2026 Form and accompanying information as soon as possible by email. This allows for keys to be sent out in a timely manner.

This year, the cost per key remains \$50.00 (max. 2 per Lot). This fee offsets the costs of replacing locks and keys, signage, printing sign-in sheets, maintaining fishing areas, etc.

Voluntary Key Recycling. This year, members may recycle their old, obsolete fishing keys. The keys can be recut by our locksmith and used for future key changes. To make the recycling process convenient, a drop box for old keys will be placed at the kiosks located in Area 1-2 and Area 4-5. Please deposit your outdated keys in these drop boxes to help support the ongoing management of the fishing access program.

Violations. Unfortunately, there were still two violations reported during the 2025 season that were appropriately dealt with by the Board, including a year-long suspension being handed down in the most serious case. We know that a few bad actors do not reflect the majority of the membership's values and good faith efforts to protect the fishery and, importantly, our fishing privileges granted by the easements. Please refresh yourself with the [Redhill Forest Regulation 16-2 rev 3 "Redhill Forest Fishing Regulations with Violation Process"](#) posted on the Association's website as you prepare for the 2026 season. We are hoping for a clean sheet this year!

2025 Violations:

- Bringing guests to non-guest Fishing Areas; and
- Failure to fully complete the sign-in sheets, including full name, time in /out, etc.

Our relationship with the Ranch Owners remains good, and compliance with this process and the regulations is necessary to maintain the positive trajectory. **The regulations will continue to be strictly enforced this year, including mandatory completion of sign-in and sign-out sheets.** This part of the process is critical to ensure Authorized Fishing Members entering a Fishing Area do not exceed the Authorized Fishing Member Limits.

Automated cameras located in each Fishing Area will continue to be monitored during the 2026 season.

Be friendly. Be observant. Authorized Fishing Members are encouraged to introduce themselves to others they encounter in any Fishing Area and to report any suspicious activity to the Fishing Committee (e.g., if the person they met does not appear on the 2026 Authorized Fishing Member List).

Keep it clean. Please do your part to keep the Fishing Areas free of litter and consider picking up cans and other trash even if it is not yours. (Pack it in, Pack it out)

Project Healing Waters (PHW). Redhill Forest is honored to co-sponsor, in partnership with our ranch owner colleagues on the Middle Fork River, Project Healing Waters (PHW). This organization provides veterans with opportunities for fly fishing, fellowship, and restorative healing. The PHW event is scheduled for July 11, 2026, from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. We kindly request that Redhill members refrain from fishing in Areas 1, 2, or 3 on the day of this event.
